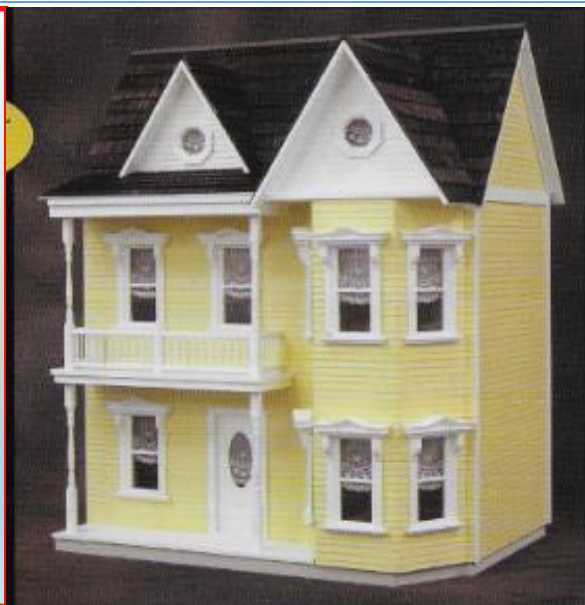
Greeters Greetings

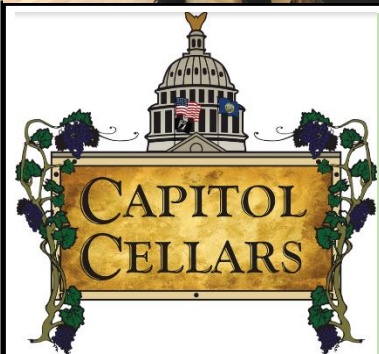

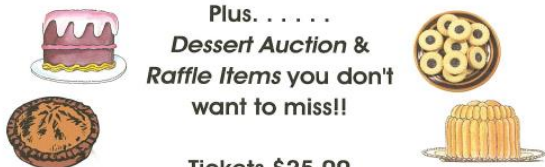
