

Mike's motto is "Go big or go home". This is where Mike's journey began. He and his crew at Excel Equipment Company built a completely new rig for the Rednecks. The new BBQ trailer has a 10 foot long grilling area. It has a gas fired smoker and grill, including a sink with hot and cold running water. The rig has it's own generator and lights. The BBQ trailer is completely self-contained with a 60 gallon propane tank, also with tanks for fresh and gray water. This BBQ trailer ended up being 18 feet long with chrome Peterbuilt smoke stacks and steel diamond plate.

Thanks to Mike Cunningham and Excel Equipment, the New Redneck Culinary Trailer is a sight to behold!






El Korah American Legion Post 100


