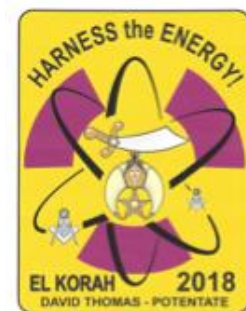

## *Portland Shrine Hospital Report*

February was another good month for the Portland Shrine Hospital with most operational parameters within expectations. Dereesa Reid, our new Administrator, has jumped into her role with vigor and, based on her report to the February Board of Governor's meeting, will be a great asset to your hospital. This month also was the first in-person Board meeting of the year with all but one Board member in attendance. If anyone has questions about the Portland Shrine Hospital, please contact Dave Triplett, Mike Mastropaolo, or Rick Holloway.

In other exciting news, Dr. William Horton, MD, Director of Research-Emeritus at the Portland Hospital, led a team that discovered a new biomarker that allows physicians to determine bone growth velocity instantaneously. "This finding could dramatically affect how clinicians treat a number of growth and bone disorders," said Dr. Horton. "Until now, no one has figured out how to track growth as it is happening. There has been a large clinical need to determine the velocity of growth without having to wait 6–12 months." Funded by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, this research is expected to have its greatest impact on the care for infants and children with bone growth disorders. Way to go, Dr. Horton!

## The MAGEC Rod and how it works

Dr. Daniel Bouton, pediatric orthopedic surgeon for the Portland Shriners Hospital, attended the International Congress on Early Onset Scoliosis meeting in San Diego.

He is one of the spine surgeons who uses the MAGEC rods to treat kids with scoliosis. Once the rod is attached to the patient's spine, extending the rod to accommodate growth is done by using an external magnetic device which lengthens the rod without surgery, thereby minimizing infections or complications resulting from surgery.
