Portland Shrine Hospital Report

As mentioned last month, the Portland Shriners Hospital finished 2018 second in the Shrine Hospital system in terms of net patient revenue. Additionally, our referrals increased 8.25%, outpatient encounters increased 13.6%, and the adjusted patient days increased 26.24%. Additional metrics showed desired progress in meeting operational goals, including decreasing the draw on the endowment and our cost per patient day. All aspects of operations are continuously monitored to be sure we are meeting our mission while being good stewards of Shrine resources.



The Portland Shrine Hospital is growing its presence on social media, with total contacts through Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, and Instagram growing each month. On top of all of that, we just celebrated our 95th anniversary! The Board members are shown to the right toasting this event with sparkling cider during our January 2019 Board meeting.
